DECREE

ON PROCLAMATION OF THE LAW ON AMENDING THE LAW ON AUDIT OF INSTRUMENT FOR PRE-ACCESSION ASSISTANCE (IPA)

The Law on Amending the Law on Audit of Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA) adopted by the Assembly of the Republic of Macedonia on the session held on 2 May 2018, has been proclaimed.

LAW ON AMENDING THE LAW ON AUDIT OF INSTRUMENT FOR PRE-ACCESSION ASSISTANCE (IPA)

Article 1

In the Law on Audit of Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA) (Official Gazette of the RM“, No. 66/10, 43/14, 154/15, 27/16 and 190/16), in Article 5 paragraph (2) point 5) in indent 4, the conjunction “or” shall be replaced with comma.

In indent 5 the full stop at the end of the sentence shall be replaced with the conjunction “or”.

After indent 5 a new indent 6 shall be added, which reads:

“- (APTIS) – at least level B2 (C2).“.

Point 6) shall be deleted.

Points 7) and 8) shall become points 6) and 7).

Article 2

Provisions of the Article 5 paragraph (2) point 5) of the Law on Audit of Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance (IPA), (“Official Gazette of the RM“, No.66/10, 43/14, 154/15, 27/16 and 190/16) and provisions of Article 1 of this Law by which a new indent 6 has been added in Article 5 paragraph (2) point 5), shall not be applied from the day of entering in force until 1 September 2018.

Article 3

The General IPA Auditor and the Deputy who have been appointed in the period from the date of this Law entering into force until 1 September 2018, shall be obliged to fulfill the requirement related

to knowledge of a foreign language at latest within one year from the date of their respective appointment.

Term of office of the General IPA Auditor and the Deputy who will not fulfill the requirement related to knowledge of a foreign language in the term as set out in paragraph 1 of this Article shall be terminated.

Article 4

This Law shall enter into force on the eighth day after it is published in the “Official Gazette of the Republic of Macedonia”.
